Indigenous Learning

- An increase in Indigenous students' accessing support in our Holistic Wellness Space. An increase in the number of staff who support this space.
- Many students regularly attended our Gathering Circles, where Gloria Manitopyes, who works on the Indigenous Education team, comes in to support cultural teachings. We have also had Indigenous Mental Health lead one session, and we will have a knowledge keeper from Siksika join us in April to teach the Blackfoot Language.
- Saturday, March 8, we took a group of students to Winsport for the Annual Miskanawah Friendship Round Dance. Students had the opportunity to immerse themselves in Indigenous culture and celebration.
- Friday, March 14, we hosted Pearl Whitequills and Albert Goulet, who generously agreed to do Pow Wow teachings, including singing, drumming, and Dance demonstrations with the Grade 10s. The students were incredibly engaged and had the opportunity to join Pearl and Albert for a healing song and dance, as well as for a round dance at the end of the performance.
