To apply for the Quest for Excellence scholarship, eligible students are invited to write and submit an online essay that is a minimum of 500 words in length, answering one of the following questions:

- How can we ensure fair and affordable housing for all Canadians?

The annual program awards a \$1,000 scholarship to 40 graduating high-school students in Canada. To be eligible, entrants must be a Grade 12 student attending high school in Canada in the September 2025 – June 2026 academic year.
