Queen's University Major Admission Awards & Queen's Chancellor Scholarship

\$36,000 (50 awards) Approx 90% average. Superior academic ability, creative and original thinking, involvement in school or community activities, and proven leadership qualities. Financial need is also a consideration. Here is a link to the scholarship listings.

Apply for one or all admission awards by submitting a single Major Admission Award Application. (MAA) You submit in your SOLUS account which cannot be accessed until you apply for admission to Queen's. *there is a practice application to begin preparing your responses

Apply for admission to Queen's through the Ontario Universities' Application Centre (OUAC) prior to **Nov 20** to meet the **Dec 8, 2023** Major Admission Award Application deadline. Deferral of admission and scholarships may be possible.

*Nomination required for the Chancellor's (2 at Robert Thirsk). Submit a paper copy of your online practice application for major awards to your counsellor by November 30, 2023. The scholarship committee will select nominees and notify them prior to the deadline. Please put your counsellor's name/email in the MAA Application in SOLUS and they will verify if you have been nominated.

TD Canada Trust Scholarship for Community Leadership

Up to \$70,000 value (20 available) Grade 12 students in their graduating year, who have consistent outstanding dedication to solving a community problem or making their community a better place. Minimum average of 75%. \$10,000 per year in tuition; \$7500 per year additional expenses, opportunity for summer employment. 600 word essay required, letter of recommendation from the school and 2 community letters of support, transcript, and statement of financial need if it applies. Option to add two other 250 word essays.
