Administration maintains the right to declare days throughout the school year as 'No Parking' days due to special events hosted at the school. i.e. Post Secondary Fairs, Tournaments, Elections

This application is for the rental of one Parking Pass only. The Pass remains the property of Robert Thirsk High School and may not be sold or exchanged. Students must park the registered vehicle in the stall allocated and display the pass on the rear view mirror. **Do not apply for a parking pass for a friend, you are the only one who will be permitted to park in the spot you are assigned.** Please only apply if you will have a valid license before the end of October 31, 2026

PARKING REGULATIONS

1. The speed limit in the parking lot is 8 km/h. Careless driving, stunting, or speeding are not allowed.
2. Students are not permitted to loiter or gather in the parking lot. School rules apply while you are in the parking lot, even if you are in your car.
3. Display your parking pass on your mirror at all times.
4. Area 1 – Upper Parking Lot parking stalls from 100 up are first come first serve. Cost is \$30+GST
5. Area 2 – YMCA Lot 1 – parking stalls are first come first served for pass holders. Cost is \$15 +GST
6. All vehicles must be parked in a marked stall. Any vehicles parked on the grass, in the roadway, in staff parking or in visitor parking without authorization risk being ticketed and/or towed.

Please note:

Administration reserves the right to revoke parking privileges if regulations are not followed - with no refund to student. Parking at Robert Thirsk High School is a privilege, and not a right. Should you not meet the behavior expectations we have for all students your parking pass will be revoked.

The school is not responsible for any injuries to students or damage to vehicles that might occur by parking in our lots.
